Award Amount: Two \$1000 Scholarships will be awarded to residents who reside in the Brunswick, Buckeye, or Highland school districts 24 years of age or older.

Description:

This scholarship fund was established by Chamber Charities of Northern Medina County to promote academic development of non-traditional students planning to or attending an accredited college/university. The “non-traditional” student is seen as an individual whose undergraduate education has been delayed or interrupted. Winners will be notified by telephone and/or email and names will be published in the Northern Medina County Chamber Alliance newsletter and social media outlets.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A non-traditional student age 24 or older
- Resident of Brunswick, Buckeye, or Highland school district
- Planning to attend an accredited college/university for an undergraduate degree or program
- Able to produce evidence of enrollment/application in a degree or certificate program

Submission Materials:

- Completed application
- High School transcript or proof of GED
- College transcript (if any)
- At least two letters of recommendation
- Writing response to three essay questions as noted in the application

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, clarity of stated goals and objectives as well as determination of need. A scholarship committee will review applications and the results will be announced in May.
