Award Amount: Two \$500 Scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from the Brunswick, Buckeye, or Highland school districts. Students at Medina County Career Center are also eligible to apply if their home school is one of these noted districts.

Description:

This scholarship fund was established by Chamber Charities of Northern Medina County to promote academic development of high school students planning to attend an accredited college/university. Winners will be notified by telephone and/or email and names will be published in the Northern Medina County Chamber Alliance newsletter and social media outlets.

Eligibility Requirements:

- High School student graduating in 2018
- Planning to graduate from Brunswick, Buckeye, or Highland High School or a student at Medina County Career Center who resides in one of the above school districts.
- Planning to attend an accredited college/university
- Able to produce evidence of enrollment/application in a degree or certificate program
- Able to produce both a current high school transcript and a final transcript upon graduation

Submission Materials:

- Completed application
- High school transcript at time of application and after graduation
- At least two letters of recommendation
- Writing response to three essay questions as noted in the application

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, clarity of stated goals and objectives as well as determination of need. A scholarship committee will review applications and the results will be announced in May.
