Award Amount: Two \$500 Scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from a school district in Medina County . Students of the Medina County Career Center are also eligible to apply as well as homeschool students who reside in Medina County.

Description:

This scholarship fund was established by MC Chamber Charities of Northern Medina County to promote academic development of high school students planning to attend an accredited college/university. Winners will be notified by MC Chamber Charities and will also be publicly recognized at a local community event and announced through social media.

Eligibility Requirements:

- High School student graduating in 2019
- Planning to graduate from a high school in Medina County including the Medina County Career Center. Also includes homeschool students graduating who reside within Medina County
- Planning to attend an accredited college/university
- Able to produce evidence of enrollment/application in a degree or certificate program
- Able to produce both a current high school transcript and a final transcript upon graduation

Submission Materials:

Completed application

High school transcript at time of application and after graduation

At least two letters of recommendation

Writing response to three essay questions as noted in the application

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, clarity of stated goals and objectives as well as determination of need. A scholarship committee will review applications and the results will be announced in May.
